Instructions



The Hall of Fame is intended to be an elite recognition of those who have moved semi-pro/minor league football forward, put forth outstanding careers on and off the field of play, and are looked at by their peers as the absolute best-of-the-

best their respective team and league had to offer. Players, coaches, administrators, trainers, volunteers, and others not listed here are all able to be nominated for consideration.

As the nominator of a candidate for induction into the Greater Northwest Football Hall of Fame, you are the narrator telling the story of the nominee's career. This should take you some time if the nominee is truly deserving.

Please be thoughtful and specific in your narrative. Simply sending in a form that says "Player X was good" will not be sufficient. Supporting documents, all-league, team honors, newspaper clippings, teammate and opposing player support for a nominee go a long way towards validating the importance of a prospect to the advancement of semi-pro/minor league football in the Greater Northwest, but are not the defining principles for induction. Each individual is examined on a case-by-case basis by independent reviewers who are tasked with gathering information to make an educated assessment. There are many nominees out there who have never been presented to the GNFA or were presented but did not include supporting documentation.

You may work with the nominee to gather supporting documentation and prepare to write the story of the nominee if that information is not readily available.

If you are self-nominating, it is encouraged that you provide as much supporting documentation as possible as well as provide a list of three (3) former teammates and (2) opponents who may be contacted to verify statements. These may be players, coaches or administrators. Embellishing or falsifying information are grounds for permanent exclusion.

Acceptance into the GNFA Hall of Fame may or may not be issued the same year as nomination. Once received, the application will be reviewed and once all seven (7) votes are received a ruling will be administered. If the nominee has not been contacted, the application is still active and may be approved or denied at a later date. If an application does not receive the needed votes, a request for further information will be issued and the nominee may respond with additional information or recommendations from former teammates and opponents.
